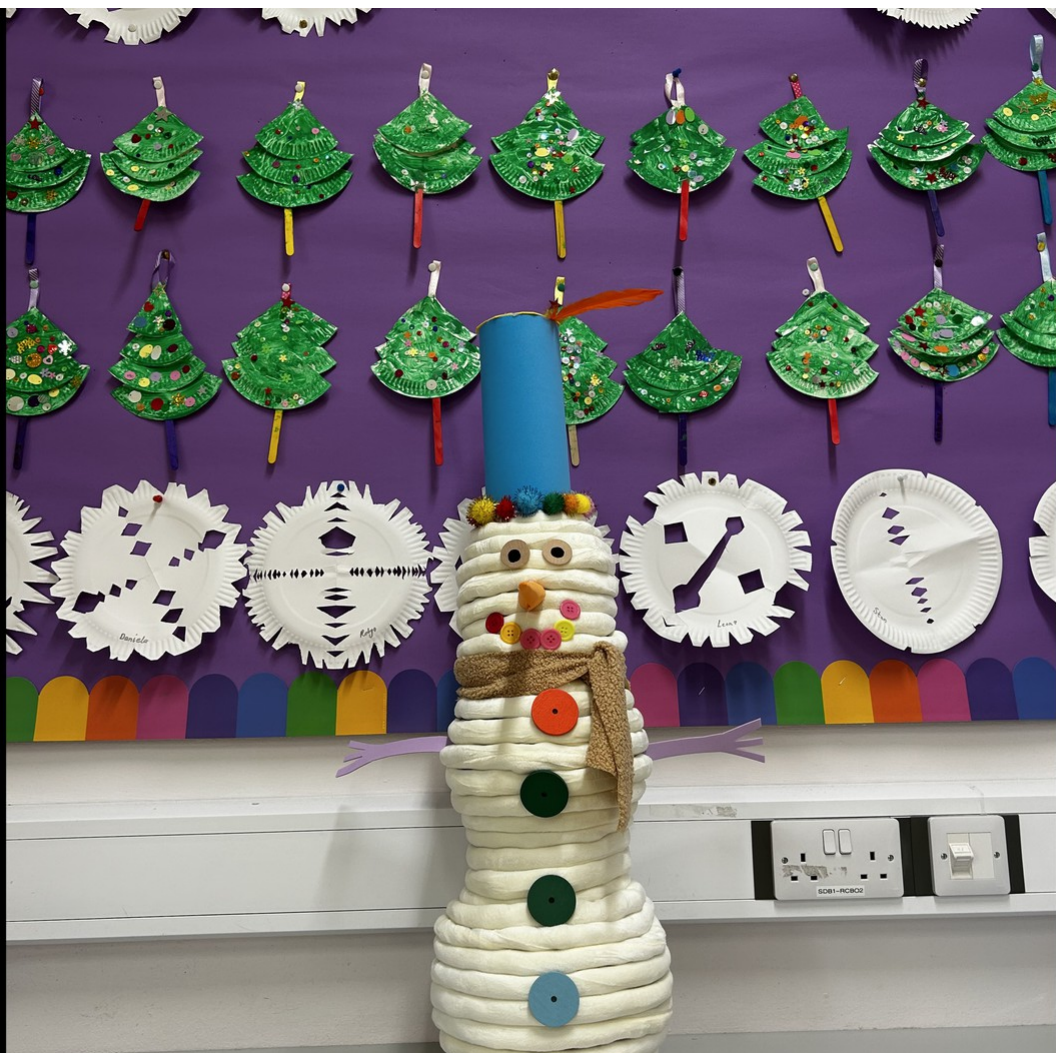




Newsletter December 2025
